



At last and at length we finally have our tall ship adventure.

On this journey leaving from Brockville Harbour, 15 St Andrew's Street, from Friday September 12th and returning on Sunday September 14th, 2026.

The cost is \$565 per person, taxes included. You will be fed on board, accommodations and we will sleep on board Friday evening. We will sleep in a protected harbour on Saturday and return on Sunday.

A 20% non-refundable deposit is required by July 7th (\$113) with the balance due on August 1st (\$452).

I can tell you from our experience, this was something you will never forget.

Once I start receiving the deposits, I will follow that with information on what to bring and what to wear.

We only have room for 15 people and it will be on a first-come-first-served basis. All of the clubs in the ON1 district are invited, and only those clubs. This is a rare opportunity I was able to arrange for our district.

You will be crew members. This is not a pleasure cruise. But you won't be alone. There are many experienced crew members on the ship. You will stand watch, call out warnings, learn to navigate the ship and check for anything untoward. And the best part - you will steer the ship!
