GUEST SPEAKER THIS MONTH: DR. JANET BIGGAR

Her topic:

"Empowered youth become tomorrow's role models"

Jim Jamer & Janet Biggar are husband and wife who initially travelled to South Africa as tourists in 2009. They returned to South Africa in 2010 (plus Zimbabwe & Botswana) and continued to learn about the people and culture of that part of the continent. In 2011, they volunteered to go to South Africa for 3 months (plus a brief visit to Zimbabwe) which culminated in the establishment of **lizidima Africa** in March, 2012.

Dr. Janet Biggar is a licensed veterinarian who established a small animal practice in Ottawa, Ontario in 1989. Her husband, Jim Jamer, managed the practice from 1990 until 2012 at which time they decided to sell the

animal hospital and devote more time to their pursuits in Africa.

The shortage of male role models in the black community continues to contribute to numerous family and societal issues in Africa.

Iizidima Africa empowers responsible, disadvantaged black male youth in their pursuit of further education and knowledge such that they may become tomorrow's role models.

Dr. Biggar is on staff at the Carling Animal Hospital at 2268 Carling Ave. (at Woodroffe).

How do I find you to get this warm welcome?

Exit Highway 417 at Eagleson/March Road. Just north of the exit take Campeau Drive west. At the first light turn right (north) onto Teron Road. At the first light, turn left (west) onto The Parkway. At the first (and only) stop sign, turn right onto Leacock Way. Follow Leacock Way to its end at Leacock Drive. Kanata United Church is in front of you, across the street. PARKING at the church is limited. If full, please park in the large lot of the school next to the church or on the side of Leacock Drive where parking is permitted.

In fact, unless you have difficulty walking, please consider parking away from the front of the building in order to allow those who may be physically restricted easier access and exit. Thank you for your consideration.
